THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THIS WEBSITE

The management methods of the site are described in the present webpage in reference to the processing of personal data referred to those who consult the website.

It concerns an informative that is also given in compliance with Section 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 – Personal Data Protection Code to those that use the web service for Lux Italy, accessible from the site http://www.luxitaly.eu which corresponds to the homepage of our company.

THE DATA CONTROLLER

Information referred to identified or unidentified persons may be processed upon the consultation of this site. Their processing is held by Lux Italy.

PROCESSING METHODS AND AREA OF DATA PROCESSING

Personal data are processed by automated instruments for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data were collected.

Processing associated with the web service of this site takes place at the offices of Interline s.r.l., via Tonale 118, Mezzocorona (Trento), and is handled only by employees, duly appointed to data processing, or possibly to those in charge of occasional maintenance operations.

All personal data deriving from this website will not be communicated or disseminated. Only anonymous data can be communicated or disseminated.

Personal data provided by users who request information material (product catalogs, price lists, samples, etc.) are used only for the means required to carry out the matter requested and are shared to third parties only in those cases necessary to fulfill such inquiries (i.e. curriers).

Specific security measures are observed to prevent loss, illegal or incorrect use of or unauthorized access to personal data.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSES

Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used for the functioning of this web site may pick up, in the course of their normal operations, certain personal data whose transmission is implicit upon communicating via the Internet. This concerns information not collected with the purpose of matching it to the users, but due to its nature may, through processes and through references with data held by to third parties, enable the identification of the users. This category of data comprehends IP addresses and domain names of the computers used by those who connect to the website, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of request, the methods used to submit the request to the server, the dimensions of the files obtained, the code number showing the server reply (correct, error, etc.) and other parameters referred to the operative system and to the user's computer environment. Such data are utilized only for the purpose to obtain anonymous statistical information about the use of the website and to ensure the proper functioning of the site, and are immediately deleted after being processed. The data may be used to establish responsibility, shall an hypothetical computer crime occur causing damage to the website: apart from such circumstance, data collected in regards to web users are deleted after 7 days.

Data voluntarily given by the users

COOKIES

The website does not purposely acquire personal data.

Cookies are not used for the transmission of personal information, nor are any other type of cookies utilized, nor other personal tracking systems.

Session cookies (which are not embedded into the user's computer and which disappear when the browser is closed) are strictly limited to the transmission of session indicators (i.e. random numbers created by the server) necessary to permit a safe and efficient navigation of the website.

The session cookies used in this website do not utilize other computer techniques potentially dangerous for the privacy of the users and do not permit the acquisition of personal data referred to identified users.
